Feedback on the First Draft of AHC09

1. It is essential to include the specialisation area of the certificate as part of the name e.g. "Certificate II in Agriculture – Livestock Production Specialising in Poultry"

2. It would be very helpful to industry for tracking activity if each qualification with a specialisation could have a separate number. This could be achieved by changing one of the numbers, as in the Horticulture part of the training package (e.g. Certificate III in Horticulture – Arboriculture is AHC31009 whereas Certificate III in Horticulture – Landscaping is AHC31209).

If there is pressure to keep the number of qualification numbers to a minimum, perhaps an additional identifier could be added to the main code e.g.

Certificate III in Agriculture – Livestock Production is AHC30309 whereas Certificate III in Agriculture – Livestock Production – Specialising in Poultry Production could be something like AHC30309(1) or AHC30309(P).

It would not be necessary to individually identify each unit of competency e.g. AHC4104A "Develop livestock feeding plans" could remain as it is but be incorporated under the specialised Certificate IV in Agriculture – Livestock Production – Specialising in Poultry Production. The use of generic units makes it essential that the context in which they are assessed is clear from the qualification in which they are completed. If qualifications do not differentiate between industry sectors, then, for example, the Unit "Feed Livestock" has to be accepted in the poultry sector, even it is was assessed in the sheep sector.

An associated issue is that, if qualifications have slightly different numbers, will RTOs need to have all the numbers in their scope of just the primary numbers e.g. AHC30309?

3. In the Diploma and Advanced Diploma, it is essential for the poultry industry that units of competence from lower levels e.g Certificate III, IV (and even Certificate II in some instances) can be incorporated. It is not possible in the poultry industry to be an effective supervisor or manager without the technical skills that are recognised in units at lower levels. People may move into poultry production with backgrounds in other agricultural industries or management expertise from outside the agricultural sector. This means that they need the industry specific skills to be able to do their jobs effectively.

4. For the Certificate IV, there are currently no poultry specific units. We recommend the development of new units to reflect the technical

developments, and related job requirements, that have transformed poultry production over the past decade.

5. For the Advanced Diploma, only an Advanced Diploma in Agribusiness is provided for in AHC09. A mechanism is needed for incorporation of technical skills, as outlined in Point 3.

6. Can some flexibility be incorporated into the training package e.g. is it essential to do exactly the prescribed number of units – in total and in each category? What about the “one-up, one-down” or “two-up, two-down” rules? Is there any reason why higher level units, at the very least, cannot be included in a qualification? We recommend that, in the packaging rules for Certificates II, III, IV and the Diploma, wording such as “level 2/3/4/5 units” be changed to “level 2/3/4/5 or above units” in each section of the packaging rules.

7. A major gap in the training package is biosecurity and quarantine. Units of competency such as AHC2412A (RTE2707A) need to be included at Levels 3, 4 and 5 also. These units of competency need to incorporate the importance of background knowledge of why biosecurity is so important. The poultry industry may recommend that the respective biosecurity unit is made a compulsory unit for a qualification specialising in poultry production.

8. There have been major changes in the environmental requirements within the poultry industry and it is essential that these are incorporated in the units of competency. New units of competency at levels 3, 4 and 5, specific to intensive industries, need to be developed.

9. Regarding the “Imported Units”, it is important that the packaging rules refer people to the list of Imported Units so that they are aware of the existence of this list. For some of the imported units, e.g. BSBMGT609A Manage Risk, it is important to have a unit which is specific to the rural industries. The needs in rural industries for climate, disease, market and environmental risk are very different from those of other industry sectors.

10 Cultural issues: provision is made in some places for sensitivity to cultural issues with indigenous Australians, which is obviously extremely important. However, there are cultural issues with other people in Australia. The poultry industry employs many people from a non-English speaking background and there are many cultural issues which need to be addressed. Can this be incorporated into the new training package in the form of a new unit?

The Poultry CRC has developed a document of Poultry Occupations and recommendations of the appropriate qualification and units of competency. This is attached for the benefit of AgriFood Skills Australia. Parts of this document could be incorporated into the poultry specialisations. This document, which is appended, includes a list of recommended new units of competency. It is essential that these new units be included in the new

package to reflect the changing work practices of the industry over the past decade.

There are some errors in the Mapping Table - some incorrect RTE numbers corresponding to the new AHC numbers:

AHC3157A is equivalent to RTE3402A (not RTE3157A)

AHC3158A is equivalent to RTE3712A (not RTE3158A)

AHC3634A is equivalent to RTE3708A (not RTE3634A)

AHC4610A is equivalent to RTE4202A (not RTE4204A)
